1	<p>Donegall Square West City Centre, beside City Hall 5-6 Spaces</p>	<p>All day drop off and pick up: 20 mins only, no return for one hour after leaving. Space for 5 - 6 coaches.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Donegall Square West, Belfast (west side of eastern carriageway) – from a point 29 metres south of its junction with Donegall Square North for a distance of 72 metres in a southerly direction.</p>
2	<p>Donegall Quay (East side) 3 Spaces</p>	<p>All day parking.</p> <p>Donegall Quay (east side) – from a point 26 metres south of the southern kerblines of Corporation Square for a distance of 80 metres in a southerly direction</p>
3	<p>Duncrue Road (East Side) 3 Spaces</p>	<p>All day parking.</p> <p>Duncrue Road (east side) – from a point 159 metres south of the southern kerblines of Dargan Crescent for a distance of 80 metres in a southerly direction.</p>

6	High Street City Centre, 0.2 miles from City Hall 2 Spaces	<p>8:00am to 6:00pm drop off and pick up Monday to Saturday: limited to 20 minutes, with no return within 1 hour after leaving. Space for up to 2 coaches.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Currently being revised to include all days</p> <p>Waiting only between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Monday to Saturday limited to 20 minutes – no return within 1 hour</p> <p>High Street, Belfast (north side) – from a point 38 metres west of its junction with Bridge Street for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction.</p> <p>The waiting restriction ceases in the evening so overnight coach parking is permitted.</p>
7	College Square North City Centre, 0.2 miles from City Hall (8 parking bays – 4 on north side, 4 on south side)	<p>On the north side of College Square North, towards the end furthest from the city centre, a new coach parking area has been created, allowing coach parking for 4 hours with no return for 1 hour after leaving, 9:30am to 7pm Monday to Saturday Current Time Restriction: 4 hours</p> <p>Waiting only between 9.30 a.m. and 7.00 p.m. on Monday to Saturday limited to 4 hours – no return within 1 hour Current Time Restriction: 4 hours</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 College Square North (north side) – from a point 38 metres west of its junction with College Place North for a distance of 55 metres in a westerly direction. 2 College Square North (south side) – from a point 20.5 metres west of its junction with College Square East for a distance of 56 metres in a westerly direction.” <p>The waiting restriction on the bays listed above ceases in the evening so overnight coach parking is permitted.</p> <p>One area on the south side of College Square North, at the end closest to the city centre,</p>

		is to have 24/7 coach parking retained.

(Bus stop)</p> <p>This Order amends the Parking Places and Loading Bays on Roads (Glengall Street, Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2009 (“the Order”) by the deletion of Schedule 1 relating to a parking place for a bus or coach.</p> <p>The waiting restriction ceases in the evening so overnight coach parking is permitted.</p>

Where possible, Belfast Castle would appreciate advance notice of coaches arriving for tours.</p>	<p>There is also an overflow car park near the playground on the other side of the castle, again coach parking is permitted on a first come first served basis and limited to max 3 coaches. These overflow car parks are open 24 hours and are free of charge. Overnight coach parking is also permitted. Please note during the day the spaces are often already occupied by visitors and wedding guests and space can be tight for manoeuvring. Please note there is no security outside opening hours.
